STEP 1 Set up your Doctor profile in the Dandy Portal

Before setting up your scanner, look for an email from Dandy (doctors@meetDandy.com) titled "Welcome to Dandy! Here's how to get started."

Follow the instructions in the email to set up a Doctor profile with Dandy.

Please note: this action should be completed by the Doctor first in order to ensure proper setup of the laptop and scanner. Office managers, Dental Assistants, Dental Hygienists and other staff members of the practice will be able to set up their own profiles in the Dandy Portal later.

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Welcome to Dandy!

Get started by setting up your Dandy Portal account where you can track your equipment order and get a head start on your onboarding checklist.

What's the Dandy Portal?

The Dandy Portal is your single source of truth for all your lab work. Manage your lab orders, check case statuses and delivery dates, get on-demand support, and so much more.

STEP 2 Set up your laptop and scanner



Find the laptop in the Dandy box and place it on a stable surface.



Turn the laptop on and wait until it's fully booted.



Find your private secured WiFi Network, select it and enter your password key.



Find the laptop charger and plug everything together.



Click on the WiFi button on the bottom right.



Turn on "Connect automatically" and click on "Connect."

We provide the J5Create adapter as a courtesy. This device is meant to be used in emergency situations when wifi is not functioning. Please leave it in the box unless otherwise instructed.



Find the scanner base and place it on a stable surface.



Find the scanner wand and place it on the stand. Notice the scanner base has two sides. One side contains a single port while the other side has two ports.



Plug the scanner wand cable into the side with the single 5-prong port.



Connect the power cable to the 3-prong port on the front of the base then plug into an outlet. When scanner is receiving power, a green light will illuminate on the back of the scanner base next to the single port.



Find the power supply and brick and connect them together.



Lastly, Using the ethernet cable, plug one end into the port on the scanner base and the other end directly into the laptop computer.

STEP 3 Set up Chairside software and calibrate your scanner



On your laptop, double-click the Dandy Chairside icon to open it.



Check that the scanner is set up and connected by looking for the green light indicator.



Sterilize the scanner and tips. Do <u>not</u> use CaviCide wipes on mirror tips.

Select the Doctor profile that you previously set up in the Dandy Portal.



Calibrate the scanner by pressing the "Calibrate" button on the Chairside home screen and following the onscreen instructions.

Get ready for training
